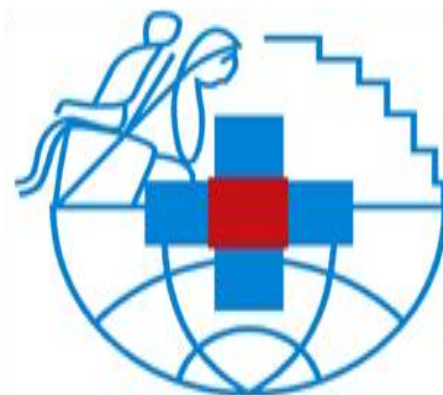

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BACKGROUND

In the preliminary phase, a group of inquisitive and conscious youths of Baguwa, Gorkha began the social campaign against the prevailing conservative culture and social system by establishing "Human Welfare Association" in 1978 A.D to serve the local people. Standing on the foundation of "Human Welfare Association" the organization remained active in health related services by establishing on altruistic Primary Health centre in 1981 A. D. in Baguwa, Gorkha. At that time when there were no health posts in the villages, the organization also provided health services to surrounding people of Oyak, Taku, Masel, Ashrang, and Taple VDCs by establishing similar Primary Health Treatment Centers. Despite the availability of primary health services of in the villages, the people were forced to enter urban cities, especially, the capital city Kathmandu for the treatment of emergent, infectious, intensive, deadly and chronic diseases . In such situation, during the treatment of a woman suffering from acute blood discharge at Maternity Home Hospital" in Thapathali Kathmandu, "BAGUWA (GORKHA) HEALTH WELFARE COMMITTEE, KATHMANDU" was established on May 14, 1993A.D as a social organization based on collective ownership in the initiation and leadership of diligent youths involved in different professions and businesses in Kathmandu.

Despite its strategy of being dedicated only in the service of Baguwa community in its initial phase, after 14 years (2006A.D) the fourth general convention of the organization allowed it to break free from all limitations and broadened its realm, taking a challenging mission of serving all working class and under-Privileged. The organization renamed itself and got registered in the name of "BAGUWA (GORKHA) HEALTH AND DEVELOPMENT SOCIETY" to fully enjoy its latest its latest liberation. Consequently, the organization was free to serve the people whole heartedly of any vicinity with its integrated development program on the basis of necessity and emergency and rising high above the limited geographical boundaries and service sectors. Though the organization adopted the policy of running self-dependent and sustainable programs with its own resources on the basis of autonomous decision, authority and ownership in the past, in today's context, to transform itself from the society of necessity into independency, it has made the decision that the organization is now free to run developmental and service related programs in collaboration with national and international organizations, and individuals who have common interest and passion to work for the under -privileged. As a result, the organization is now achieving refined and concrete shape from its raw and liquid state.

the organization witnessed a major metamorphosis during the year 2011A.D as it changed its former name i.e." BAGUWA(GORKHA) HEALTH AND DEVELOPMENT SOCIETY" to a more sovereign and universal name as "HEALTH, EDUCATION, AGRICULTURE AND DEVELOPMENT NEPAL (HEADS NEPAL) " as pre the conclusion derived from the historic sixth General Convention, but without deviating from its quintessential objectives. The organization is now impartially serving every kind of people irrespective of class, caste, sex and political belief in whatsoever way it is capable of.

INTRODUCTION OF THE ORGANIZATION

With the aim of solving various problems among themselves through collective effort, HEADS Nepal was initially established by the conscious youths of Baguwa who came to Kathmandu to start their own businesses and careers. the organization now has the objective of promoting the idea of purely collective service among the rural people (countryside multitudes) according to their level and capability . Furthermore, it also has the responsibility of extending its services, on behalf of social interest, from the local community to national and international level.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

In the context, when science and technology has transformed the world in to a global village, and billions of people into a community, the organization has the following aims and objectives:

- Emancipating the world community from physical and mental barriers
- Creating a healthy, balanced and effective world community through tools of development like Health, Education, Agriculture and people related Developmental activities
- Assurance of emergent services and health security along with the integrated development
- Working as an important partner to transform the world from the society of necessity in to the society of independence

IMPORTANT ACTIVITIES AND PROGRAMS

The instrumental activities and programs conducted and executed by HEADS Nepal so far:

- Consultant services for the identification of doctors and hospitals according to the nature of diseases
- Facilitating the care-taking relatives of the patient during their stay at the hospital
- Providing financial grant up to Rs2000 per patient as per the financial status and emergent events
- Additional financial assistance for the patients as per the requirement of patients and the capability of HEADS Nepal

- Periodical (Quarterly) blood-donation programs since the establishment of organization
- Providing stretchers to the countryside branches
- Fund- raising through different social programs
- Provided medical services at Lamachaur, Gorkha 1997-2003 A.D.
- Provided NRs 10,000/- for the treatment of the injured and disabled of the people's movement of Nepal 2005 A.D.
- Conducted general medical health camp and distributed medicines free of charge at sikhre, Lamachaur, Rithepani and Dandada of Baguwa, Gorkha on June 2007 A.D.
- Four days-long health awareness training was conducted for the women of rural families on June 2007 A.D.
- Pro-lapse campaign (with free medicine) was held in Baguwa, Gorkha on February, 2007 A.D. in collaboration with Manamohan Memorial Hospital. The 43 patients, who had been referred to Kathmandu for the surgery, were operated from the financial support of community service Foundation, Bhaktapur
- A gynecological camp was held in collaboration with community service Foundation Bhaktapur, in Ghyampesal, Gorkha on 2008 A.D.
- Formation of the Consumer Committee in the leadership of Gorkha Baguwa branch and assistance from the Central committee which succeeded to influence the Central plan of the then Government to allocate budget to finance the Baguwa Water Lifting Supply and Sanitation Project
- Inception of Hospital construction and development Fund with more than NRS 5,00,000/- residing
- Flood- victims have been provided financial support every year
- Construction of Martyrs' Memorial Passenger rest Spot at Lamachaur of Baguwa, Gorkha
- Financial support for rural electrification
- Construction Child Health Campaign in collaboration with Medical Checks for Children (MCC) Netherlands for three consecutive years 2009, 2010 and 2011 A.D which will be continued in the days to come ahead
- Developed a strong foundation of above 3000 General Members (NRS 365/- per year), 200 Life Members (NRS. 10,000 for once in a life time) and 2 Super Members (Shreyashkar) Members (More than NRS.100,000/-) and the number is still increasing from Gorkha, Kathmandu, Bhaktapur, Lalitpur, Rasuwa, Dhading, Nuwakot, Tanahaun, Lamjung, Baglung, Gulmi, Chitwan, Jhapa, Kavre, Sindhupalchowk, Rolpa etc.
- Established a co-operative name "Daraudi Saving and Credit Co-operative" with investments from the team members of HEADS Nepal to excel economically

FUTURE PROGRAMS

The organization has the vision and action plans as mentioned below:

- Disseminating and promoting the concept of the organization via national and international campaigns
- Investigating, studying, researching, evaluating and monitoring closely health, education, agriculture and developmental activities.
- Establishing the organization's own publication unit and library
- Conducting the service- oriented and result- oriented programs through partnership, collective and participatory approach in integrated programs (education, health, agriculture, transportations, communication etc.) for the all-round development of the people
- Conducting the program of unequal collection, and equal distribution and service on the basis of necessity and emergency
- Producing, collecting and distribution through public- health cooperatives and integrated (financial, social and cultural) scientific system
- Working in coordination with similar type of governmental and non- governmental organizations
- Establishing a community based hospital on 15 May 2013, which will be gradually developed into a Medical College and Hospital
- Establishing and promoting Center for Technical Education and Vocational Training as well as Agricultural College which will be the very foundations of Agricultural University to be developed in future
- Cultivating high breed plants and groceries in thousands of hectares of land through Agro-forestry which can be an epitome for the entire world to see
- Providing ambulance/corpse- carrying vehicle services
- Establishing, conducting and developing training centers, information centers, hospitals, teaching hospitals and medical colleges and institute in rural as well as urban areas to reach more and more people
- Constructing and running orphanages, and shelters for disabled and senior citizens
- Establishing primary health -care centers in rural areas as per the necessity
- Assisting the government in the developments of herbs-farming, processing and market management along with promoting the research for the herbs at the local level
- Conducting various health treatment camps including mobile health services

- Playing a vital role of an assistance to the role in the social, economical and cultural transformation of the people

ON NATURAL CALAMITIES AND DISASTER

- Playing active role at the incidence of flood, land-slide, earth quake, fire, other natural calamities and epidemics.
- Working as a volunteer during the accidents on water, land and air transportation depending on HEADS' capacity

INTEGRATED DEVELOPMENT

- Assisting the rescue , rehabilitation and management of the displaced and victimized due to domestic and external conflict
- Supporting the farmers in vegetable -farming , horticulture and animal-farming to fulfill the need of balanced diet
- Raising public awareness for clean kitchen, clean and safe toilet and ecological balance
- Conducting the sustainable and self- dependent multipurpose cooperatives development campaign for the economic, social, and cultural transformation of the ethnic minorities, women, suppressed, exploited and working class people
